2. Packing & marking:

- 2.1 Manufacturer's name or brand name to be quoted against the name of articles or registered trade mark if any.
- 2.2 For transportation, the articles should be well packed.

3. Bid Price / Contract Price:

- 3.1 The contract shall be for the **full Items only** as described above, partly quoted items will be treated as **non-responsive**.
- 3.2 Corrections, if any, shall be made by crossing out, initialing, dating and re-writing failing which the quotation shall be treated as **non-responsive** at the discretion of the purchaser (Director, A.H. & Veterinary Department, Assam, Chenikuthi, Guwahati-3)
- 3.3 Suppliers shall be entirely responsible for all taxes, duties, license fees, octroi, etc., incurred until delivery of the contracted goods to the purchaser.
- 3.4 The price should be quoted in Indian Rupees only (Both in word and figure)
- 3.5 Quoted bid price shall include the packing, transportation charge, loading, unloading and other incidental charges excluding the taxes.
- 3.6 Bid/ contract price shall be fixed and firm and not subject to adjustment / variation during the performance of the contract.

4. Bid Security (Earnest Money):

The bidder shall enclose a bid security amounting to Rs.10,000.00 (Rupees ten thousand) only in the form of a certified cheque/call deposit/term deposit or demand draft from a nationalized/scheduled commercial bank located in India duly pledged in favour of the **Director, A. H. & Veterinary Deptt., Assam, Guwahati-3**.

The purchaser shall reject the bids that not accompanied by the aforesaid requisite amount of bid security. The bid security of the unsuccessful bidders will be released immediately after signing of the contract with the successful bidder and the bid security of the successful bidder will be released upon submission of the performance security and signing of the contract agreement.

As the purchaser notifies the successful bidder that their bid has been accepted by issuing award of contract, within 15 days, the bidder shall furnish the performance security in accordance with the Conditions of Contract.

Failure of the successful bidder to comply with the requirement of the Clause 4.3 shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of the bid security,

in which event the purchaser may make the award to the next lowest evaluated bidder or call for new bids.

5 Validity of Bid:

- 5.1 Quotation shall remain valid for a period not less than 45 (forty five) days after the deadline date specified for submission or beyond any period of extension subsequently requested by the purchaser. Purchaser shall reject a bid as non-responsive for shorter period of validity.

6 Evaluation of Bid:

- 6.1 The purchaser will evaluate and compare the quotations determined to be substantially responsive i.e. which are:
- (a) complete in all respect,
 - (b) properly signed and sealed on all pages of the purchased bidding document & submitted along with the bid,
 - (c) To conform specifications for each Items provided with Samples.
 - (d) Enclosed by all the required documentary evidences/ **Requisite amount of bid security or Earnest money/Registration certificate of firm/Tax clearance certificate/Manufacturing Licence/ Experience certificate/ technical brochure/manuals/Brand name if any.**
 - (e) Clause 6.1 above shall strictly be considered as qualification criteria for evaluation of bid.
- 6.2 The purchaser may call for any clarification(s) / document(s) from any or all the bidders during the process of evaluation of the quotations WITH SHORT NOTICE failing which the offer shall be considered as Non Responsive.
- 6.3 The quotations shall be evaluated in **aggregate of contract price for full items** only excluding taxes. Quoting partially the Schedule of Requirement or for selected destination will be treated as non-responsive.
- 6.4 To facilitate prompt evaluation, the bidder shall quote rate as per prescribed format attached (**Price Schedule**)
- 6.5 The mandatory Govt. Sale Tax/VAT payable shall be indicated separately for the goods. These will however not be considered for evaluation.
- 6.6 Preference shall be given to bid/goods with quality certificate during evaluation ignoring the price factor.

7 Delivery Period:

- 7.1 Delivery of the goods shall have to be completed by the supplier strictly within 7 (Seven) days to the consignee from the date of receipt of the supply order. Quotations not conforming to this provision shall be rejected as non responsive.
- 7.2 Penalty of Rs.100.00 (Rupees one hundred) only per day will be imposed in case of failure to deliver the goods on time and will be calculated from the last date of delivery period (day). Quotations not conforming to this provision shall be rejected as non responsive.
- 7.3 The amount of penalty will be recovered from the performance security furnished by the bidder for the goods.
- 7.4 Exemption: The supplier shall not be liable for failure to perform any of its obligations under or arising out of this contract if such failure results from any force majeure, fire, storm, earthquake, explosion, accident, strikes, lockout, industrial dispute, labour trouble, transportation embargo or the existence of any state of emergency, war or war-like condition, civil commotion, riot or imposition of sanctions and/or any measures taken by the government whatsoever which renders it impossible or impracticable for supplier's liability to perform obligation under this contract.

8. Place of Delivery:

As per Schedule of Requirement time to time order will be placed in phase manner for different quantities for **different FOR destination of delivery.**

9. Inspection & Testing of the goods:

- 9.1 The quality certificate of feed to be obtained from the Competent Authority/P.C./A.N. Laboratory of this department and submitted for each consignment as well as along with bid.
- 9.2 The purchaser reserves the right to reject the defect goods after delivery (whole or part) even after delivery of the goods and replacement of defect goods shall be on bidder's cost and responsibility.
- 9.3 If the bidder having been notified and fails to replace the defect(s) goods within 15 (fifteen) days, the purchaser may proceed to take such remedial action as may be necessary at the bidder's risk and expense and without prejudice to any other rights which the purchaser may have against the supplier under the contract and may lead to forfeiture of the performance security.

10. Special Terms and Condition:

- 10.1 The supply of feed by the bidder at the approved rates/ contract price can not be stopped all of a sudden on the plea of delayed payment and at least 120 (one hundred twenty) days prior notice must be given to the purchaser.
- 10.2 The bidder must supply quality feed as per approved specification and standard in net quantity as per supply order in Sealed Packet. No extra charges will be paid for packet and packing.

11. Sampling of goods (Feed & Feed Ingredients)

- 11.1 Sealed **plastic airtight containers of size 300 gms having 250grms of sample** of each items (marking particulars of items on the pack) as per Schedule of Requirement shall be submitted by the participant bidder **at the time of submission of bid.**

12. Award of contract:

- 12.1 Purchaser shall award the contract to the bidder to **approve the firm with offered rate** for 1(one) year from the date of signing of agreement, whose quotation has been determined to be substantially responsive **{fulfilled the qualification criteria as above at clause 6.1(d)}** and who has offered the lowest evaluated quoted price (**lowest aggregate of contract price for full Items**) throughout the year. Supply order shall be issued by the purchaser **for different quantum of different Items for different destination in phase manner time to time.**
- 12.2 Notwithstanding the above, the purchaser reserves the right to accept or reject any quotations and to cancel the bidding process and reject all quotations at any time prior to the award of contract without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder/ bidders or any obligation to inform the affected bidder/bidders of the grounds for the purchaser's action.

- 12.3 The purchaser is not bound to accept the lowest rate quoted by the bidder if not fulfilled the qualification criteria.
- 12.4 The decision of the Director, A.H. & Veterinary Department, Assam, Chenikuthi, Guwahati-3 shall be final in case of any dispute.

13. Payment:

- 13.1 Payment shall be made on satisfactory delivery of the goods by the supplier and acceptance of the goods by the consignee/ purchaser.
- 13.2 The supplier shall submit the following documents to the consignee/ purchaser along with the goods:
- i) Supplier's invoice (in triplicate) with challan showing the contract number, supply order no. for each consignment, goods description, quantity, unit price, total amount and taxes.
 - ii) Packing list identifying the content.
 - iii) Quality certificate of the item.
- 13.3 The remittance of amount deducted on taxes at source of payment, the purchaser shall make issuance of certificate for such deduction.
- 13.4 Payment of the bills will be made at the earliest time after observing the necessary formalities subject to availability / release of fund by the Govt. by way of FOC.
- 13.5 All payments shall be made in Indian Rupees only.

14. Performance Security:

- 14.1 Within fifteen (15) days on issuance of notification of award to the successful bidder by the purchaser, the successful bidder/supplier shall furnish a performance security; an amount of 20,000/- for due performance of the contract in the form of a certified cheque/call deposit/term deposit or demand draft from an Indian Nationalised Bank drawn in favour of the **Director, A.H. & Veterinary Department, Assam, Chenikuthi, Guwahati-3.**
- 14.2 The performance security shall be valid for 14(fourteen) months (two months beyond contract period.)
- 14.3 At the same time upon submission of performance security, successful bidder/supplier shall also sign an **agreement in a Non Judicial Stamp Paper of Rs.20/-** with the purchaser for due performance of the contract.
- 14.4 If the successful bidder upon receipt of notification of award fails to furnish the required performance security within the stipulated time, the notification of award issued shall be treated as cancelled and shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of the bid security. In this event the purchaser reserves the right to make the award to the next lowest evaluated bidder or call for new bids.

15. Qualification Criteria:

- 15.1 The bidder must be a reputed manufacturer or their authorized dealer.
- 15.2 The bidder should enclose the following document with the bid:
- a) List of **client/Users list** with contact address and phone number at least for the last one year.
 - b) In case of authorized dealership, attested copy of authorized dealership certificate.
 - c) In case of manufacturer, copy of the license for manufacturing the similar goods from the competent Authority.
 - d) Technical **literature/brochure** in support of the goods.
 - e) Attested copies of up-to-date **Tax clearance/ VAT Registration and PAN No.**
 - f) Submission of Purchased **bidding document** along with **bid**, properly signed and sealed on all pages to abide terms & conditions of this bidding document.

- g) **Requisite amount of bid security or Earnest money.**
- h) Registration Certificate of the Firm.
- i) Registration Certificate under Shops and Established Act.
- j) Manufacturing License of the Manufactures.
- k) Experience Certificate of Manufacturers for preparation of feed as specified in the Tender for last 5 (five) years.
- l) In case the Manufacturer wants to represent through authorized Dealer, valid Certificate to this effect may be submitted. However the Dealer should meet all the Terms and Conditions and other requirements of Tender/ Bidding document.
- m) Quality Testing Certificate of feed from the Competent Authority / P.C./A.N. Laboratory of this Department. Firms submitting Tender shall have to furnish their full Postal Address along with Telephonic Nos. (if any) for communication along with details of Partner/ Proprietor/ Director/ Member.
- n) (i) In case of Proprietorship Firms the name of the Proprietor with Signature and Seal shall have to be furnished.
(ii) In case of Partnership Firms the list of all Partners with their Signature, Seal and full address along with the copy of the Partnership Deed should be submitted and in case of Company the copy of Memorandum should be submitted along with the bid.
- o) Clause 6.1 of bidding document shall be considered for evaluation.

16. Opening:

- 16.1 The bids/quotations shall be received up to 14.00 hours (IST) **on 12-04-2010** and opened at 14.30 hours (IST) on the same day in the office of the Director, A. H. & Veterinary Department, Assam, Chenikuthi, Guwahati-3.
- 16.2 The bidder or his authorized representative may attend the bid opening process. Except bidder's name, bid security and un-evaluated quoted price no other details shall be announced during bid opening process
- 16.3 In the event of the specified date for the submission of bid/quotation being declared a holiday for the purchaser, the bids/ quotation will be received up to the appointed time on the next working day and will be opened at the appointed time and location on the same day.
- 16.4 Each bidder shall submit only one quotation/bid.
- 16.5 The NIQ number and Date should be written visibly on the top of the sealed bid/ quotation/Tender.
- 16.6 You are requested to provide your offer latest by 14.00 hours (IST) **on 12-04-2010** (date).
