2. **Profile of Nagaon District:-**

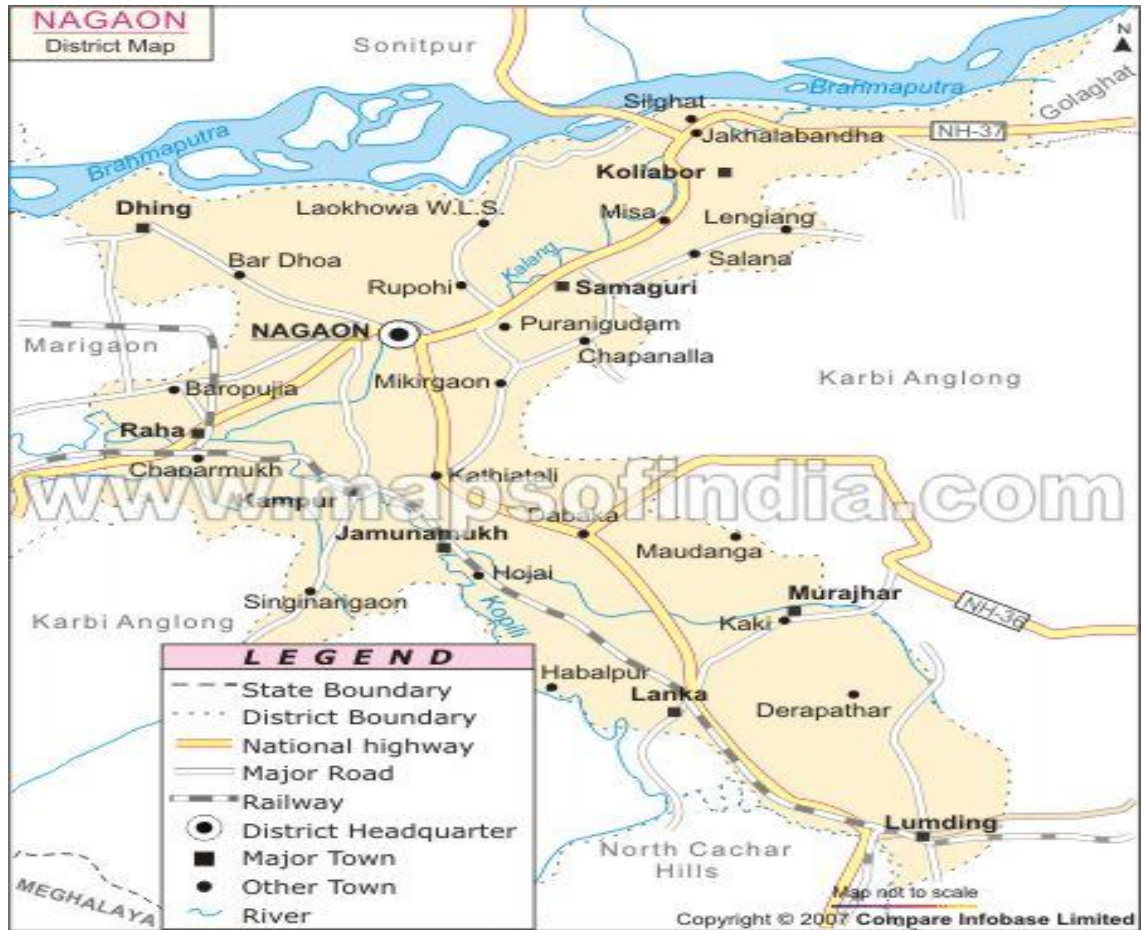
Nagaon district is situated at 25.45 deg. And 26.50 deg. N. latitude & 93.20 deg. E. longitudes, located in the centre of Assam covering an area 3973 sq. K.M. The district is bounded on the north by the river Brahmaputra, on the south & southeast by Karbi Anglong district, Golaghat district in the east and on the west Nagaon District is covered by Morigaon district. The district HQ Nagaon is situated at a distance of 123 Km. East of Guwahati, the capital city of Assam. Historically this district was earlier known as 'Khagarigan' during the Ahom Reign, under Swargadew Pratap Sinha. To name few historically important places are Doboka, Chapanalla, Devasthan, Kondoli and Jugijan etc. The most notable place of historic importance is however the Batadrava popularly known as Bardowa, about 15 km. away from Nagaon town. It was the birth place of Srimanta Sankardev who was the nucleus of a Vaishnavite revolution influencing and uplifting all the spheres of Assamese culture, Religion, Literature. Sculpture, Painting, Drama and so many more to count. The district comprises of plains char areas and hilly terrain. Although, the river Brahmaputra that flows along the northern boundary of the district is the main river, its two tributaries Kalong and Kapili may be aptly mentioned as the life force of the district as the fertile areas on the bank and around these rivers have been the centres of agricultural farming communities of the district.

The climatic condition is mostly humid in nature and so the district is vulnerable to epidemic diseases like malaria, diarrhoea etc. The hilly terrain particularly on the southeast part of the district is malaria prone area while adjacent areas of the river Brahmaputra, Kapili, Barpani and Jamuna are flood prone area.

The National Highway No. 37 traverses the district from east to west while the National Highway 36 goes from Nagaon town towards southeast. The total length of PWD roads in Nagaon district is 2018 km. out of which 323 Km. is surface. Nagaon town is well connected by Rail and Road and the nearest Air port is at Barjhar, Guwahati which is about 140 K.M. from Nagaon Town and another Airport at Tezpur which is around 80 KM from Nagaon Town.

The population of the district comprises mainly of mixed population. Although, agricultural is the prime occupation, there exist 35 no of Tea gardens and two agro based industries i.e a jute mill at Silghat and a sugar mill at Kampur in the district. The district is rich in forest resources also. A part of Kajiranga National Park, which is famous for one horned rhino, attracts the tourist not only from India but also from abroad.
